- UpSparks Flash Cards
- UpSparks printable bingo cards <u>free download</u>
- Bingo chips, marker, pencil, coins, etc.

How to play

- 1. Select one player or a parent/teacher to be 'caller' for the game
- **2.** Hand out a <u>bingo card</u> to each player (each card must be different)
- **3.** 'Caller' shuffles the flash cards thoroughly then places the deck in front of them (answers facing down)
- **4.** The 'caller' then reads out the top facing card question
- **5.** Players mark off each square (using chips, marker, pencil, coins, etc.) containing the answer to the caller's question.

Winner

 The first player to mark off a line (row, column, or diagonal) on their card with all correct answers; and call out BINGO!

Expand the game

- → Have players create their own Bingo cards using the <u>UpSparks blank card</u> <u>template</u>. Make sure players don't duplicate numbers and keep in mind that some answers (eg. 0, 12, 24, 36) occur more than others (eg. 1, 25, 49, 64, 144).
- → Extend the game by requiring the winner to fill their whole card (this can be a long game)
- → Try 'Knockout Bingo', where the game is inverted and players are knocked out as they call out BINGO! The winner is the last player left.
- → Have your caller throw in some humor using <u>classic Bingo nicknames</u>: "One little duck multiplied by legs eleven!"
